June 2-11 at the Academy of Music

Philadelphia, PA (May 5, 2011) –Pennsylvania Ballet brings its 2010-2011 Season to a joyous conclusion with Sir Frederick Ashton's beloved romantic comedy, *La Fille mal gardée*, June 2-11, 2011 at the Academy of Music.

"*La Fille* is a true gem in our repertoire, a near-perfect narrative ballet," Artistic Director Roy Kaiser says. "Ashton strikes just the right balance of technically demanding dancing, tender moments, and flat-out fun."

Loosely translated as "The Wayward Daughter," *La Fille mal gardée* is Ashton's touching tale of two determined lovers and their quest to marry. Lise, the young daughter of a wealthy farmer, is in love with Colas, a handsome, young farm worker, but her mother disapproves. Instead, she arranges for Lise to marry Alain, the eccentric, simpleton son of a successful vintner. Set along a backdrop of simple country life, this uplifting ballet is brimming with charming characters, memorable dances, and hilarious antics like dancing hens and even a live pony! A heartwarming story, *La Fille mal gardée* illuminates the spirit of true love.
