# ballet

Ballet uses dance and music to tell a story.

Dancers are both human and animal characters.

The Snow White Ballet tells the story of Snow White, the Seven Dwarfs, the Prince, the Evil Stepmother, and the Huntsman.



# music

You will hear music during the whole ballet.

The music also helps me understand how the characters are feeling.

The music helps me know if the scene is scary, happy, or funny.





# costumes

In ballet, dancers wear costumes.

Wearing costumes is like playing dressing up.

The costumes help me know the character of each dancer.



# the forest

The forest is where Snow White gets lost and falls to the ground.

Friendly characters find and help her.



# jealousy

The Evil Stepmother is jealous that the magic mirror says Snow White is the fairest.

Jealousy is a feeling you have when you want what someone else has.





# mean

The Witch makes a poison apple to give to Snow White. If a person eats a poison apple they will get sick and fall asleep.

A person is mean when they try to hurt someone's feelings or to make someone else feel bad or get sick.



# sleeping curse

The Witch tricks Snow White into eating the poison apple.

The poison apple gives Snow White a sleeping curse, and she falls into a deep sleep.





# love

Love is a feeling when a person cares for another person.

Snow White will wake up when the Prince falls in love with her.
